 - 1. Introduction: Principal Biggs's 9th year at TRHS now!
 - 2. Currently virtual but preparing for hybrid model beginning November 10. Fall sports will resume 11/10 as well, in time for regionals. Hybrid/virtual split is about half and half.
 - 3. Questions from Board:
 - 1. All virtual courses are for full credit for graduation credit.
 - 2. Assemblies and indoor gatherings/ ceremonies on pause still (i.e. Hall of Fame)
 - 3. Space for social distancing is not ideal, but in classrooms should be okay. Halls, meals, etc., present most difficult times b/c of logistics and spacing. Maintaining main gym for PE and basketball.
 - 4. Ideas for support from board?
 - 1. Needs assessments: Board members will reach out to Principal Biggs to determine needs, research costs. Considering support for students, especially Seniors, student athletes/ performers/ artists as well.
 - 2. Mak Suceska will lead effort to research resources for desk shields and/or face shields
 - 5. No specifics on make-up days at this point, but may make up minutes in 2nd semester by lengthening school days in short increments. Still pending.
