Principal's Update Mindy Euken

Speech & Debate: Students (Bianca, Vaughn) who were given Opportunity Scholarships to attend an international tournament in Taiwan came to give a recap of their trip. Their team advanced to the top four (out of 35 international teams). One of them ranked third as an individual speaker.

They use evidence in their debates in a way different from how we do in the US. Our students were able to learn from and adopt some of the international presentation styles.

Mindy's Report:

The bond passed. Districtwide, the impacts will include an increase in access to full-day preschool and daycare. Redesigning the Middle School experience; Developing Interest-Based Signature Schools; Preparing students for successful futures after graduation; providing high-quality K-12 activity, art, and athletic programming and facilities.
